

# Vizio Divina continued

At the heart of Visio Divina is the prayerful practice of gazing. To gaze upon something is to look steadily and intently on it with deep emotional involvement. While we could gaze upon something with amazement, gazing in Visio Divina is meant to bring us to love that which we are gazing. Just as parents gaze their newborn child with awe and affection, just so we gaze upon an artistic scene in order to find a deeper love for God. To practice Visio Divina, we start with a chosen text from Scripture along with an artistic representation of that passage.

- 1. Read the passage, letting its words sink in.
- 2. Then gaze at the picture. The artist, guided by the Holy Spirit, has included subtle layers of images in the work. Be open to what the artist, and ultimately God, wants you to see or notice.
- 3. Pray. Let the things that you noticed move your heart to share with God your thoughts and ponderings.
- 4. Contemplate. Consider how this image leads you to a deeper connection with God.
- 5. Action. Our response in action is the fruit of contemplation. Confronted with the awesome reality of God's great work in Salvation History, we ponder what we can do to make that love more visible today.
