

Luminous Mysteries: The Baptism of the Lord

In 2002, Pope Saint John Paul II announced the addition of the Luminous Mysteries to the Rosary history in addition to the traditional mysteries of the rosary. The Luminous Mystery Rosary or the Mysteries of Light, as they are also called, focus on the public life of Jesus, the years He was preaching spanning the time between His Baptism and His death. They are called the Mysteries of Light because Jesus is the light of the World. Today we look at the first of the Luminous Mysteries:

The Baptism of the Lord

- 1. John was baptizing on the other side of the Jordan.
- 2. And all Judea, the inhabitants of Jerusalem and the surrounding region came out to him to be baptized.
- 3. Jesus also came to him to be baptized.
- 4. I should be baptized by you.
- 5. Give in for now, so that we can fulfill all right-eousness.
- 6. So, he allowed him to be baptized.
- 7. As Jesus was coming out of the water, the heavens opened before him.
- 8. And the Holy Spirit came upon him like a dove.
- 9. And a voice was heard, "You are my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased. My favor rests upon you."
- 10. Then the Spirit drove him into the desert to be tempted.

Romans 9:1-5

St. Paul said: "I speak the truth in Christ — I am not lying, my conscience confirms it through the Holy Spirit — I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were cursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my people, those of my own race, the people of Israel. Theirs is the adoption to sonship; theirs the divine glory, the covenants, the receiving of the law, the temple worship and the promises. Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of the Messiah, who is God over all, forever praised!"
