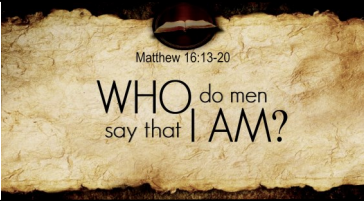

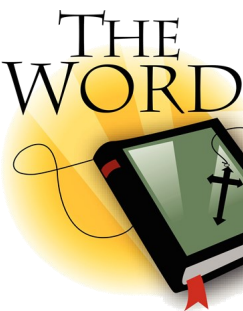

Luminous Mysteries: The Wedding at Cana

We return once again to the short phrases that one could say while reciting the Rosary. By mentioning or thinking of these phrases before each Hail Mary, we can easily contemplate that particular mystery. Today we can consider how to pray the Second Decade of the Luminous Mysteries: The Wedding Feast at Cana.



The Baptism of the Lord

- 1. There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee.
2. The Mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding.
3. In the course of the celebration, the wine went out.
4. They have no more wine.
5. Woman, how does this concern of yours affect me? My hour has not yet come.
6. Do whatever he tells you.
7. Fill those jars with water and take some out to the steward.
8. People who give a banquet serve the choice wine first, then, after they had drunk a while, a lesser vintage.
9. You have kept the good wine until now.
10. This was the first of Jesus' signs and his disciples began to believe in him.

Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God!
How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!
34 "Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?"

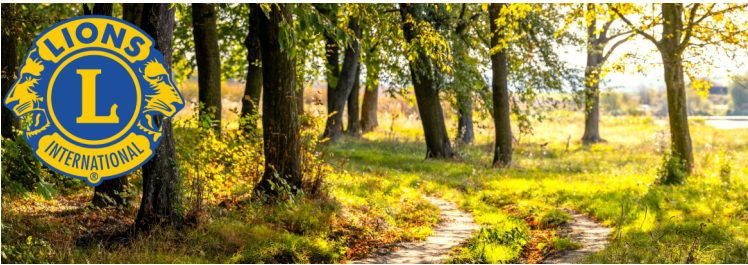
