**Joyful Mysteries:
The Finding
in the Temple**

With this installment, we complete looking at the sen-
tences that can be said before each Hail Mary as we pray
the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary. Next week, we will
begin to look at the newly added Luminous Mysteries.
The Finding in the Temple
1. Mary and Joseph were accustomed to celebrating
the Passover Festival in Jerusalem
2. When Jesus was twelve years old, he accompanied
them on the journey.
3. At the conclusion of the festival, they prepared to
return to Nazareth, but Jesus stayed behind in the
Temple.
4. After searching for three days, they found him in
the Temple, listening to the scholars of the Law,
and asking them questions.
5. All who heard him were amazed at his understand-
ing and his answers.
6. Son, why have you done this? For three days, your
father and I have been looking for you in sorrow.
7. But why were you looking for me? Did you not
know that I had to be in my Father's House?
8. He went down with them to Nazareth and was
obedient unto them.
9. And he grew in wisdom, age, and grace before
God and the people.
10. And Mary treasured all these things and pondered
them in her heart.

2 Peter 1:16-19
For we did not follow cleverly devised stories when we
told you about the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ in
power, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. He re-
ceived honor and glory from God the Father when the
voice came to him from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This
is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." We
ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when
we were with him on the sacred mountain. We also have
the prophetic message as something completely relia-
ble, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a
light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the
morning star rises in your hearts.
