



### **ABOUT PRAYER: Luminous Mysteries:** the Institution of the Eucharist



The last of the Luminous Mysteries is the Institution of the Eucharist during the Last Supper.

#### The Institution of the Eucharist

- 1. The disciples prepared the Passover Supper in the room Jesus had indicated.
- 2. I have greatly longed to have this Supper with you.
- 3. Amen, Amen I say to you, I will not taste again the fruit of the vine until I drink it new in the Kingdom.
- Then he took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave 4. it to them.
- 5. Take this and eat. This is My Body, which will be given up for you.
- 6. Then he took the cup filled with wine, blessed it, and gave it to them.
- 7. Take this and drink. This is the cup of My Blood, which will be poured out for you.
- Do this in memory of Me. 8.
- 9. When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes again.
- 10. For his Flesh is real food and his Blood is real drink.
