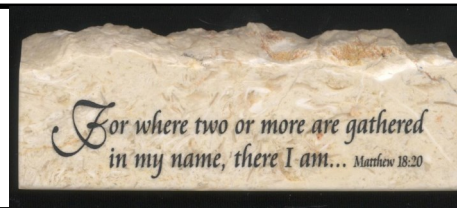

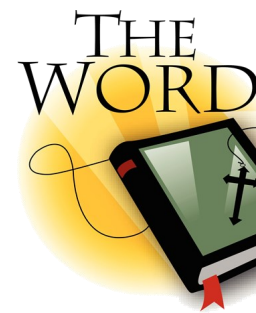

Luminous Mysteries: the Institution of the Eucharist

The last of the Luminous
Mysteries is the Institution of the
Eucharist during the Last Supper.



The Institution of the Eucharist

1. The disciples prepared the Passover Supper in the room Jesus had indicated.
2. I have greatly longed to have this Supper with you.
3. Amen, Amen I say to you, I will not taste again the fruit of the vine until I drink it new in the Kingdom.
4. Then he took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them.
5. Take this and eat. This is My Body, which will be given up for you.
6. Then he took the cup filled with wine, blessed it, and gave it to them.
7. Take this and drink. This is the cup of My Blood, which will be poured out for you.
8. Do this in memory of Me.
9. When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes again.
10. For his Flesh is real food and his Blood is real drink.

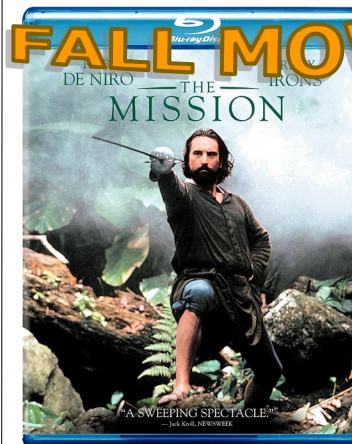
