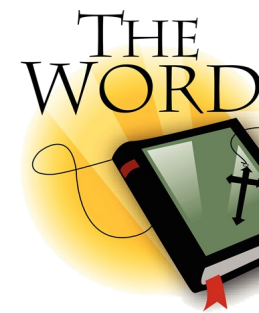

The Sorrowful Mysteries: the Agony in the Garden



We have been presenting short sentences that can be said before each Hail Mary as we pray the Rosary. Today, we turn to the Sorrowful Mysteries that depict the sufferings of the Lord Jesus that frees us from sin and death.

The Agony in the Garden

1. Jesus took Peter, James, and John with him into the Garden of Gethsemane.
2. Stay here while I go over there to pray.
3. Father, if it be Your will, let this cup pass me by.
4. But let it be as You will, not I.
5. Coming back, he found the disciples sleeping.
6. Can you not watch with me for one hour?
7. Father, if this cup cannot pass me by without my drinking of it, Your will be done.
8. And his sweat became like drops of blood.
9. And a crowd armed with swords and clubs came out to arrest him.
10. Judas, will you betray the Son of Man with a kiss?

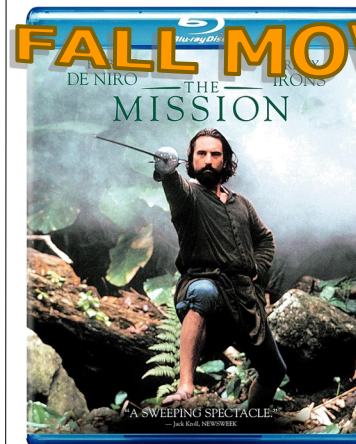


We Really Need You!
