The Scouring at the Pillar

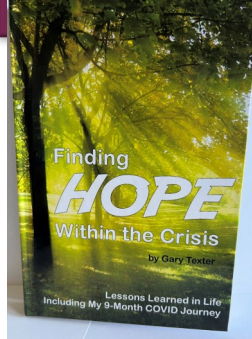
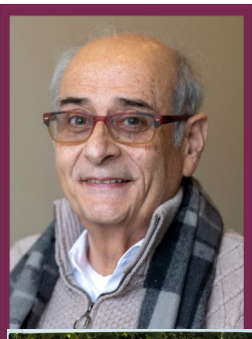
1. Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate for interrogation.




Catechetical Sunday
