

ABOUT PRAYER:

Luminous Mysteries: the Kingdom and the Transfiguration

As we come to next set of the Luminous Mysteries, the Proclamation of the Kingdom, there is a slight change. Instead of having 10 short verses that can be said before each Hail Mary, here there are only 5. After saying each verse, one then says 2 Hail



Marys before referring to the next verse. Then, coming to the Fourth Luminous Mystery, the Transfiguration, we resume having 10 verses that help us be focused on the Mystery:

The Proclamation of the Kingdom

- 1. Jesus went through all the towns and villages of Galilee, preaching in their synagogues.
- 2. This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand.
- 3. Repent and believe in the Gospel!
- 4. They brought to him many who were sick, and he cured them all.
- 5. They also brought many who were possessed, and he drove out all the demons.

The Transfiguration

- 1. Jesus took Peter, James, and John up a high mountain.
- 2. He was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun.
- 3. His clothing became whiter than any bleach could make them.
- 4. There appeared two men: Moses and Elijah.
- 5. They were conversing with Jesus about the Exodus he was about to do in Jerusalem.
- 6. How good it is to be here! Let me erect three booths, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.
- 7. A cloud covered them, and they became afraid.
- 8. A voice came from the cloud, "This is my Beloved Son with whom I am well pleased. Listen to Him!"
- 9. When they looked up, they saw Jesus alone.
- 10. Coming down the mountain, Jesus said, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has risen from the dead."
