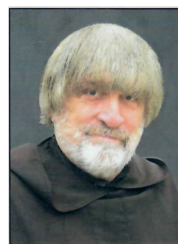

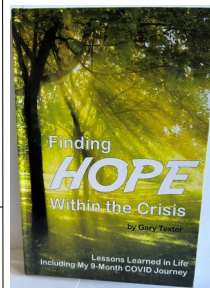

Jesus Carries His Cross

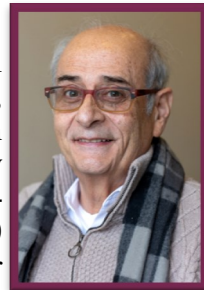
1. Jesus is condemned to death.

8. Jesus speaks to the women of Jerusalem.
9. Jesus falls the third time.
10. Jesus is stripped of his garments.
