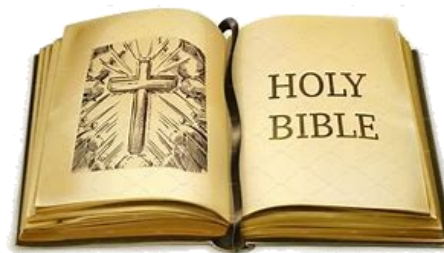

LIVING THE LITURGY:

The Greatness



How tempting and alluring is the desire for fame and fortune. How often we exalt people simply because they are famous. How much we yearn to be praised and honored for the work we do. And how different are all these things from the ways of God.

James and John have already heard about the sufferings that Christ would undergo, yet the message had not yet sunk in. They bravely retorted that they could indeed drink the cup of bitter sufferings that Jesus would drink and be baptized in the blood of the cross, but did they really know what that meant? Do we know what it means when we say that we want to follow Jesus? Do we know what it means when we pray, “Thy will be done”?

They asked to sit on Thrones of Glory. Jesus instead offers only the Throne of Grace where mercy flows in loving and humble service to others. Acceptance of suffering and total commitment to doing the Will of God are the signs of the true disciple. Any other sign of greatness is really only empty and meaningless show.

Who in your life has served you in a way that you found inspirational?
How could you emulate that service?

How have any of your own sufferings brought you closer to Christ?

One of Gandhi's “Seven Societal Sins” is “religion without sacrifice.”
